Sport & Recreation

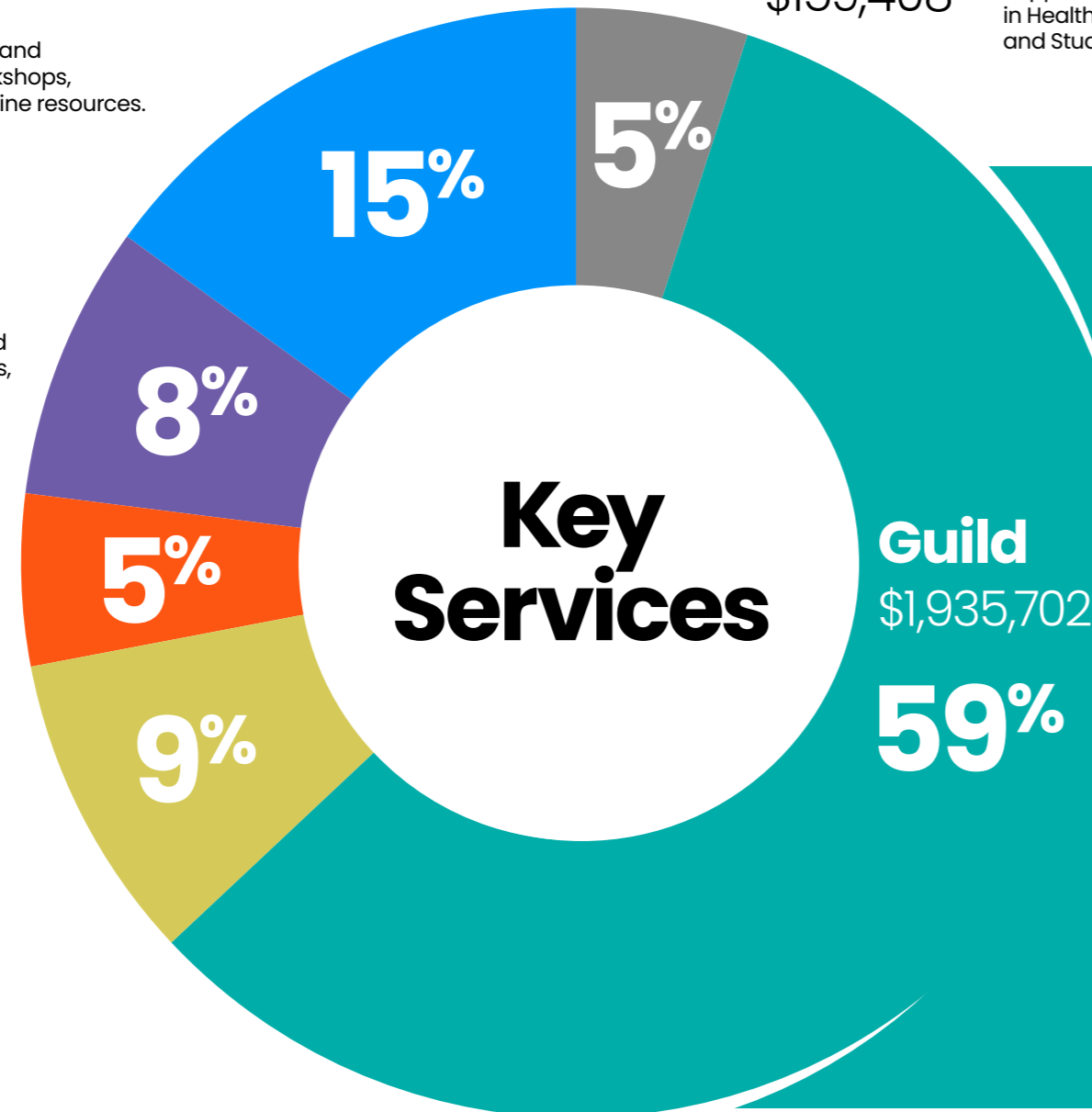
\$300,000
