DIVERSITY AT MURDOCH AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Australian Government has provided funding for scholarships/payments through the New Colombo Plan Mobility Grants. The criteria for which includes being an undergraduate student, being aged between 18 – 28 by the time the program commences, being an Australian Citizen and may not have received a New Colombo Plan Mobility grant payment previously. The program costs AU\$2,000 per student. The total amount of \$3,000 will be deposited into student's bank accounts. Students are responsible to pay the AU\$2,000 directly to O.P. Jindal and a copy of the deposit must be emailed to Shirley Jones on s.jones@murdoch.edu.au. Please note: the \$2,000 includes accommodation, food and activities as part of the programme.

Students may also be eligible under the OS-HELP loan scheme for financial assistance since they are undertaking some of their course of study overseas. However to be eligible, students must have a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average. Students must have completed a minimum of 24 credit points to apply for OSHELP and students must have at least 3 credit points left upon returning from the program.
